What's the difference between truancy and chronically absent?

Truancy

- Counts only unexcused absences
- Emphasizes compliance with state laws
- Relies on legal and administrative solutions

Chronically Absent

- Counts ALL absences: excused, unexcused, suspensions
- Emphasizes academic impacts of missed days
- Can be remedied by good habits, parent involvement and communication
