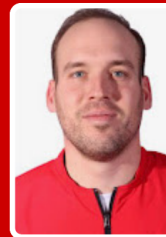

INDUSTRY 4.0

Diploma Distinction

THE INDUSTRY 4.0 DIPLOMA DISTINCTION IS A DISTINCTION THAT ALLOWS STUDENTS TO PURSUE A CAREER IN A HIGH-NEED, HIGH-SKILL INDUSTRY WHILE IN HIGH SCHOOL.

Students who earn the Industry 4.0 Diploma Distinction MUST complete:

- At least nine (9) dual enrollment or work-based learning (WBL) credits aligned with students' career goals during their junior and senior years of high school.
- Receive monthly career coaching and counseling to better prepare students for their transition to the workforce.
- Students will have the option to substitute a WBL or dual enrollment course, as approved by the State Board of Education, for one math credit and one science credit.

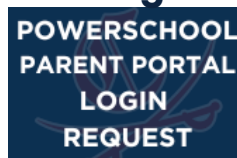

CELL PHONE / ELECTRONIC DEVICE VIOLATION DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES

<p>Warning</p> <p>Teacher contacts the parent about the violation.</p> <p>The teacher takes the phone to administration and the offense is documented in PowerSchool.</p> <p>Student is able to pick the phone back up at the end of the school day.</p>	<p>The teacher takes the phone to administration and the offense is documented in PowerSchool.</p> <p>The student is assigned to either 1 day of after-school detention or 2 days of lunch detention.</p> <p>Phone is held and given back at the end of the 1 day of after school detention OR phone is held for the day and given back after each of the 2 days of lunch detention. (It is the responsibility of the student to turn in his/her cell phone to the Main Office upon arrival to school on the second day of their lunch detention.)</p>	<p>The teacher takes the phone to administration and the offense is documented in PowerSchool.</p> <p>Student serves 1 day of ISS. The parent is required to pick up the phone after the student has served the day of ISS.</p>	<p>The teacher takes the phone to administration and the offense is documented in PowerSchool.</p> <p>Student serves 3 days of ISS. The phone is given back after each day of ISS served. (The phone will be turned in to the ISS teacher each morning.)</p> <p>For the remainder of the year after the 4th offense, the student checks in the phone at the office (Main Office) at or before 8:00 a.m. every school day, and the phone is returned to the student at 3:00 p.m. at the end of every school day.</p>

How to Create an Account

The first time, you must create an account using the school's assigned Access ID and Password from a letter sent home at the beginning of school. Your school can also help you with this information.

Things you will need to create your account:

- District Code BQHG is the 4-digit code for Putnam County School System**
- The secure access ID Access- this ID comes in a letter from their school within the first nine weeks or parents/caregivers can contact the school.**

Get started by clicking the log-in page. *Tutorial videos are also available on the log-in page.

I have an account, what is next?

Once you have created a login, use your User ID and Password when you log in each time.

How To Add Student and 5 Enrollment forms for new students.

Setting Up Automatic Reminders:

- 1. Once you log in, choose Email Notifications on the left.**
- 2. Click each box with the information you would like to receive, how often and to what email address.**
- 3. Click submit.**

PowerSchool Mobile App

- 1. Install App (Apple or Android)**
- 2. Enter District Code BQHG is the 4-digit code for Putnam County School System**
- 3. Login using the Student or Parent username and password.**

Troubleshooting:

Having issues logging in? It may be that your email is already tied to a PowerSchool account. Please contact your school to have your password reset.

Mobile App: If parents/caregivers are having issues with the mobile app (seeing last year's info, etc.), they need to delete the app and reinstall it. The old app is being directed to the old URL so a reinstall should fix the problem.
